P.R.I.D.E. Instructor Agreement

The University of Georgia Traffic Injury Prevention Institute (GTIPI) and the P.R.I.D.E. program are committed to providing a comprehensive statewide traffic safety education program for youth and their families. The mission of the P.R.I.D.E. program is to help reduce the risk of teen related car crashes and to minimize traffic-related trauma. In order to achieve this mission, GTIPI needs volunteers to carefully consider the expectations and responsibilities listed below, as well as understand what to expect of GTIPI. Please read and sign where indicated below, if in agreement.

P.R.I.D.E. Instructors agree to:

- Observe a two-hour P.R.I.D.E. class, in addition to the six-hour classroom instruction in order to gain certification.
- Teach a minimum of four (4) P.R.I.D.E. classes per year as outlined in the Instructor Guidelines and provide GTIPI notice of these classes.
- Re-certify annually in order to maintain certification and continue teaching.
- Notify GTIPI of any address, agency, email or phone number changes.
- Complete and submit all required class paperwork promptly upon completion of the class.

GTIPI agrees to:

- Provide instructors with the needed materials for registered classes.
- Provide instructors with continuing updates on information and issues concerning teen drivers, as well as a listing of other certified P.R.I.D.E. instructors.
- Act as a resource and provide support to all P.R.I.D.E. instructors.
- Give recognition for instructors' commitment and dedication to the program.
- List available certification, re-certification and P.R.I.D.E. class opportunities available on the GTIPI website: www.ridesafegeorgia.org.
- Maintain this agreement in the Georgia Teens Ride with P.R.I.D.E. volunteer instructors' file at GTIPI.
