P.R.I.D.E. INSTRUCTOR STANDARDS & CODE OF CONDUCT

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY, SIGN AND SUBMIT WITH YOUR APPLICATION

All instructors with the University of Georgia Traffic Injury Prevention Institute and the Georgia Teens Ride with P.R.I.D.E. program must adhere to the following Standards and Code of Conduct when administering a P.R.I.D.E. class:

1. Instructors are to teach the P.R.I.D.E. curriculum as outlined. Examples of behaviors that are unacceptable and may result in suspension of your certification include the following:
 - a. Teaching the class without a current curriculum or current certification.
 - b. Using any portion of the P.R.I.D.E. curriculum or videos in presentations, other than P.R.I.D.E. classes, without the written permission of the University of Georgia. **All training materials are copyrighted and the property of the University of Georgia.**
 - c. Charging participants a fee or soliciting donations for attending a P.R.I.D.E. class.
 - d. Conducting training for the purpose of certifying other instructors, without certification as a Master Trainer.

2. Instructors are to conduct themselves in a professional and respectful manner. As a P.R.I.D.E. instructor, you are representing your respective agency or organization, GTIPI and the University of Georgia.
 - a. Personal attacks, use of offensive language, or negative comments towards parents, teens, other instructors and/or GTIPI and the University of Georgia are unacceptable.
 - b. Any conduct deemed inappropriate towards parents and teens will not be tolerated.

3. Instructors are to spend adequate time studying and reviewing the curriculum prior to teaching the class. Instructors must come to the class prepared.

4. Instructors are to notify GTIPI of all scheduled classes **prior to** announcing them to the public. A completed R & A form must be received.

5. Instructors are to complete and submit all required class paperwork to GTIPI within five (5) days of completion of the class.

I have read, understand and agree to adhere to the Standards and Code of Conduct set forth by the University of Georgia Traffic Injury Prevention Institute when performing duties as a Georgia Teens Ride with P.R.I.D.E. instructor. Failure to comply with the Standards and Code of Conduct may result in my certification being suspended or revoked and my agency and/or P.O.S.T. Council being notified of the infraction.
